1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 353.656, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Duty disability; computation of benefits.** (a) A member of the police
1.7and fire plan who (1) is not a firefighter covered by section 353.6511, or a police officer
1.8covered by section 353.6512, (2) has a condition that meets the definition of a duty disability
1.9under section 353.01, subdivision 41, and (3) has filed an application under section 353.031
1.10that was approved by the executive director is entitled to receive disability benefits during
1.11the period of disability in an amount equal to 60 percent of the member's average salary as
1.12defined under section 353.01, subdivision 17a, plus an additional 3.0 percent of that average
1.13salary for each year of service in excess of 20 years.

1.14 (b) To be eligible for a benefit under paragraph (a), the member must have:

1.15 (1) not met the age and vesting requirements for a retirement annuity under section
1.16353.651, subdivision 1; ~~or~~

1.17 (2) met the age and vesting requirements under ~~that subdivision~~ section 353.651,
1.18subdivision 1, but does not have at least 20 years of allowable service credit; or

1.19(3) met the vesting requirements under section 353.651, subdivision 1, is at least age
1.2055, has at least 20 years of allowable service credit, and has not had a termination of public
1.21service.

2.1 (c) If paragraph (b), clause (2) or clause (3), applies, the disability benefit must be paid
2.2for a period of 60 months from the disability benefit accrual date and at the end of that
2.3period is subject to provisions of subdivision 5a.

2.4 (d) If the disability under this subdivision occurs before the member has at least five
2.5years of allowable service credit in the police and fire plan, the disability benefit must be
2.6computed on the average salary from which deductions were made for contribution to the
2.7police and fire fund.

2.8(e) A member is eligible for a duty disability benefit under paragraph (b), clause (3), if
2.9the condition is not based at all on a psychological condition as defined in section 353.032,
2.10subdivision 1, and the condition, injury, or illness on which the duty disability application
2.11is based occurred when the member is at least age 55.

2.12EFFECTIVE DATE.This section is effective the day following final enactment."
