This is in response to your electronic mail request of April 3, 2001, that I prepare an amendment derived from sections 2 and 3 of S.F. 1445 (Solon); H.F. 1532 (Murphy).

The requested amendment, drafted blind for incorporation into any appropriate vehicle, is attached, Amendment LCPR01-167.

Amendment LCPR01-167 permits members of the Duluth Teachers Retirement Fund Association (DTRFA) to make full salary contributions to the pension plan during periods of receipt of Workers Compensation. It also provides partial DTRFA post-retirement adjustments to retirees who have been retired for less than 12 months.
