a. Pre-Retirement Mortality

Male: 1983 Group Annuity Mortality for males set back 5 years
 Female: 1983 Group Annuity Mortality for females set back 2 years

Post-Retirement Mortality

Male: 1983 Group Annuity Mortality for males set back 2 years
 Female: 1983 Group Annuity Mortality for females set back 1 year

b. Separation

During each of the first three years of covered employment the rate is 250 separations per 10,000 occurrences. After the first three years the following rates apply per 10,000 occurrences:
