

\_\_\_\_\_ moves that the Legislative Commission on Pensions and Retirement, under its authority specified in Minnesota Statutes, Section 356.215, Subdivision 18, approve the request from Milliman, consulting actuary for the Bloomington Fire Department Relief Association to replace the 1971 Group Annuity Male Mortality Table, without margins, projected to 1976 by Scale E and set back seven years for females mortality assumption, with the following mortality assumptions:

**Mortality Rates:**

**Pre-Retirement Mortality for Healthy Lives**

RP-2000 non-annuitant generational mortality table with white collar adjustment, set back two years for males and females.

**Post-Retirement Mortality for Healthy Lives**

RP-2000 annuitant generational mortality table with white collar adjustment for males and females.

**Post-Retirement Mortality for Disabled Lives**

RP-2000 healthy annuitant generational mortality table with white collar adjustment, set forward eight years for males and females.
