

AARP Testimony on Secure Choice Implementation Legislative Commission on Pensions and Retirement March 25, 2025

Chair Frentz and Commission Members,

For nearly a decade, AARP has advocated for the creation of an impactful Secure Choice Retirement Program in Minnesota. AARP is a nonprofit, nonpartisan organization dedicated to helping people ages 50 and older improve their quality of life as they age.
