

1.1 ..... moves to amend S.F. No. 1986; H.F. No. 1779, as follows:

1.2 Pages 1 to 2, delete sections 1 to 3

1.3 Page 2, before line 18, insert:

1.4 "Section 1. **[352.88] STATE PROBATION OFFICERS.**

1.5 Subdivision 1. **Eligibility.** A probation officer is entitled to elect a special retirement  
1.6 annuity under subdivision 3 if the probation officer retires after December 31, 2027, and is  
1.7 at least age 60 or has at least 35 years of allowable service credited for employment as a  
1.8 probation officer. Except as otherwise described in this section, the probation officer must  
1.9 meet all eligibility requirements specified in this chapter applicable to a member of the  
1.10 general state employees retirement plan to be eligible for the special retirement annuity  
1.11 under subdivision 3.

1.12 Subd. 2. **"Probation officer" defined.** As used in this section, "probation officer" means  
1.13 a state employee employed by the Department of Corrections in an employment position  
1.14 listed in clauses (1) to (3) or in an employment position that the executive director determines  
1.15 to be a predecessor or successor to an employment position listed in clauses (1) to (3). The  
1.16 employment positions are:

1.17 (1) corrections agent;

1.18 (2) corrections agent career; or

1.19 (3) corrections agent senior.

1.20 Subd. 3. **Special retirement annuity.** A probation officer who satisfies the eligibility  
1.21 criteria under subdivision 1 is entitled to receive a special retirement annuity calculated as  
1.22 provided under sections 352.115 and 352.116, except that the reduction for retirement before  
1.23 normal retirement age must not be applied to the portion of the retirement annuity attributable  
1.24 to the year or years of allowable service credited for employment as a probation officer.

1.25 Subd. 4. **Additional contributions.** In addition to the employee contribution under  
1.26 section 352.04, subdivision 2, each probation officer must contribute 5.39 percent of salary.  
1.27 These contributions must be made in the manner provided under section 352.04, subdivisions  
1.28 2 and 4.

1.29 Subd. 5. **Retroactive applicability.** This section applies to allowable service credited  
1.30 for employment as a probation officer that occurs before and after January 1, 2026."

1.31 Page 3, line 5, delete "For" and insert "In addition to the employee contribution under  
1.32 paragraph (a),"

2.1 Page 3, line 6, delete "contribution is ..." and insert "must contribute 5.47"

2.2 Page 3, line 7, delete "paragraph" and insert "paragraphs" and delete "or" and insert  
2.3 "and"

2.4 Page 3, delete section 6 and insert:

2.5 "Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 353.30, is amended by adding a subdivision to  
2.6 read:

2.7 Subd. 1d. **Probation agency employees.** (a) A probation agency employee who  
2.8 terminates public service under section 353.01, subdivision 11a, after December 31, 2027,  
2.9 and is at least age 60 or has at least 35 years of allowable service credited for employment  
2.10 as a probation agency employee is entitled, upon application, to a retirement annuity under  
2.11 paragraph (b).

2.12 (b) A probation agency employee who satisfies the eligibility criteria under paragraph  
2.13 (a) is entitled to receive a retirement annuity calculated as provided under section 353.29,  
2.14 subdivision 3, except that the reduction for retirement before normal retirement age must  
2.15 not be applied to the portion of the retirement annuity attributable to the year or years of  
2.16 allowable service credited for employment as a probation agency employee.

2.17 (c) This subdivision applies to allowable service credited for employment as a probation  
2.18 agency employee that occurs before and after January 1, 2026."

2.19 Renumber the sections in sequence

2.20 Amend the title accordingly
