Mr. Louis Claeson, League of Minnesota Municipalities, discussed the problem of temporary help and seasonal help; either 90 days is realistic - maybe it should be 120 days. Mr. Claeson stated that the League will be looking at this question.

Chairman requested that Mr. Claeson give this subcommittee the pros and cons on the subject of temporary employment.

Mr. Ousdigian will give the subcommittee a list of the things in his present PERA law that can be dropped and that are obsolete.

Relative to fulltime students, Mr. Ousdigian and his staff will develop language to clarify the parttime student rule and 90 day rule and agree on the obsolete language to be omitted from the law.

MEMO - Duluth Hospital- PERA Member - memo was read and discussed.

Rep. O'Neill moved that legislation be drafted for the next session that includes therein a deleting of that portion of Chapter 224 which allows the Duluth hospital employees to release themselves from membership in PERA. CARRIED.
