

PERA SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING
November 19, 1970 - Room 125

Mr. Jim Jacobs - representing School Board Association, made the following statement for the association:

1. The employer is the governmental subdivisions represented by the school boards, the municipalities and the counties of the State.
2. Board should have representation from each of the three employer groups.
3. This proposal is a result of discussion with Dean Lund, Ralph Keyes and Louis Claeson.

Sen. Baldy Hansen moved that the PERA recodified basic law bill be referred to the full commission as a recommendation of the PERA subcommittee. CARRIED
