Minutes of previous meeting approved as presented.

Mr. Harry Groschel, Social Security Department, presented a proposed supplemental plan which would apply to individuals with salaries over \$15,000 per year (\$15,000 or over). The plan is for the State to match the first \$9,000 on which deductions are taken; anything over \$9,000, the State to match 50% of it. \$18,000 per year salaries or over to be eligible for the 50% matching.

623 in the classified service would qualify for the plan.
Cost per year - \$249,535
If the present 12% salary increase is adopted by civil service, the increase would be \$481,000. This increase would bring in 512 individuals.

67 unclassifieds receiving between \$15,000 and \$18,000 per year. Cost to cover the unclassifieds on present salary - \$73,000.

If the 12% should be put into effect, cost would be in the neighborhood of \$100,000.

Staff Memo - <u>Proposed State Employees Supplemental Plan</u> - No action taken. Mr. Blixt presented the "Minnesota Supplemental Fund" plan - an optional plan for unclassified MSRS members.
