MINUTES

Chairman, Rep. Don Moe, opened the meeting.

Present: Representatives Moe, Parish, Cal Larson, Robert Johnson.

H.F. 1580 (Moe) - St. Paul Firemen's Relief Assn.

Mr. Tom Gelbmann, St. Paul Fire Dept., explained H.F. 1580. This bill entitles a member to draw a maximum pension after 25 years of service. Normal Cost - 3/10 of 1%. Bill has city council approval.

Rep. Moe moved that H.F. 1580 pass and be placed on the Consent Calendar. Motion Carried.

H.F. 1579 (Moe) - St. Paul Police

Mr. Dick Feider, St. Paul Police Relief Director, explained H.F. 1579. Bill pertains to permanent and total disability on the job where a member has more than 20 years of service but less than 30. Deals with a select group of members under 50 years of age. Bill has city council approval.

Rep. Moe moved that H.F. 1579 pass and be placed on the Consent Calendar. Motion carried.

H.F. 358 (Moe) - TRA Benefit Bill

Mr. Harvey Schmidt explained the new amendment to strike everything after the enacting clause which incorporates the additional changes. Cost figures from Brown & Flott, TRA actuaries, were also submitted--figures on a 1.2 and 1.3 formula.

Mr. Schmidt explained that this newly incorporated bill includes the information in H.F. 358, H.F. 1127, and all items in the second housekeeping bill, reflecting change in mortality tables. The survivor benefit provisions are not in this bill.

H.F. 1673 (Parish) - PERA

Mr. Ousdigian presented an unofficial engrossment of H.F. 1673 which incorporated all of the changes.

Discussion:

Rep. Moe moved to amend H.F. 1673, the typewritten bill, by striking everything after the enacting clause and inserting the unofficial engrossment. Motion Carried.
