MINUTES

The chairman, Rep. Moe, opened the meeting.

Present: Rep. Moe, Patton, Parish, Cal Larson, Robert Johnson

H.F. 890 (Enebo) Stenvig Bill

Mayor Stenvig explained that H.F. 890 and S.F. 798 would enable anyone who has been in the Police Relief Association pension fund who is elected to a city office to continue in the police fund while he is serving in an elected capacity with the city. These bills would also restrict him to belonging to only one city pension fund.

The following amendment was placed on H.F. 890:

Page 1, line 9, after "Minneapolis" insert "with 10 years of service or more"

Page 2, line 9, after "such" strike "mayor" and insert "member"

Rep. Johnson moved that H.F. 890 as amended be recommended to pass. Carried.

H.F. 2151 (Skaar) Red Lake Falls Fire Department

After discussion as to changing the bylaws of this department to conform with the guidelines, it was decided to lay this bill over until something is worked out.

H.F. 2254 (Moe) Legislators' Pensions

H.F. 2254 was amended as follows:

Page 1, line 25, strike "January 1, 1967" and insert "January 4, 1973"

Page 2, line 7, strike "January 1, 1971" and insert "January 4, 1973"

Page 2, line 9, strike "January 1, 1971" and insert "January 4, 1973"

Rep. Moe moved that H.F. 2254 as amended be recommended to pass. Carried.

H.F. 1906 - Highway Patrol 5 High Year

After discussion it was the conclusion of the subcommittee to combine the contents of H.F. 1906, 1905 H.F.2382 into one bill.

H.F. 1906 (Patton) included the 5 high year provision
H.F. 1905 (Patton) and H.F. 2382 include the widows' provisions.

Major Johnson was directed to have language drawn up to include the provisions of H.F. 1906, 1905 and 2382 into one bill plus the necessary provisions concerning the MAFB Fund.
